PRODDY PLUS

with Gail Dufresne

Get a whole new dimension to your work by using prodding for a 3-D tactile delight. There will be several patterns from which to choose, some of which can be found at Gail's website <http://www.goathilldesigns.com>. She can also help you design your own pieces or you can choose a preprinted design.

Gail Dufresne has been hooking since 1984. She is a McGown certified teacher and has taught at camps and private workshops around the United States, Canada, and England since April 2000. Gail has taught classes and dyeing, inch mats, sheep, sunflowers, sculpting, proddy, mixed media, optical illusions, and geometrics. Her rugs have been featured in Celebrations VII, VIII, IX, XII, and XIII. Her "Sunflowers", a Jane Flynn design, went on to win the Celebrations VII contest and appeared on the cover of the June/July/August 1998 issue of Rug Hooking Magazine. "Lizards and Ladders" game board rug, which appeared in Celebration XII, was part of an exhibit at the Wadsworth Athenaeum in Hartford, Connecticut and both that piece and "Goat Hill Goat" were part of an exhibit at the Textile Center of Minnesota.

Gail has written several articles for Rug Hooking Magazine (see Jan/Feb 2010) and is currently on the Rug Hooking Magazine Editorial Board. She was one of four judges for Celebration X and XIX and her rugs have appeared on the cover three times. Gail wrote the dye section for Elizabeth Black's book "Hooked on the Wild Side" published in 2004.

SHADING WITH SPOTS

with Ingrid Hieronimus

This class will explore the possibilities of shading with spot dyes combined with their matching solid colors. Shading with spots can be just as easy as shading with a swatch or with dip dye. You may use any size cut you wish. The pattern may be a crewel, realistic floral, primitive floral, or geometric. Bring your own pattern, a commercial pattern or purchase one from Ingrid. Expand the possibilities of spot dyes!

Ingrid is the owner of Ragg Tyme Studio in Petersburg, Ontario. She is an accredited OHCG Teacher, a Certified McGown Teacher and has her certificate in Fibre Arts – Traditional Rug Hooking from St. Lawrence College. Ingrid has been featured in Celebrations and is internationally known for her teaching, dyeing, and rug hooking. She is also the author of three dye books. Ingrid has been hooking for 30 years and has been teaching and dyeing for about 18 years.

LEARN TO HOOK

with Yvonne Muntwyler

This course is designed to introduce the beginner student to the craft of Traditional Rug Hooking. By the end of the weekend you will be well on the way to finishing your first piece. The course will include: rug hooking technique, equipment, types of rug backings, colour and design, dyeing (demonstration), the use and care of cutting machines, and finishing techniques. You will receive plenty of handouts for future reference and contact to teachers and rug hooking organizations so you can continue your journey into rug hooking when you leave the school.

Yvonne has been an accredited OHCG teacher since 1984 and teaches all levels of rug hooking. She teaches weekly classes in her Burlington, Ontario studio as well as special subject workshops by request.

Anne is a rug hooking teacher qualified for over 35 years in both the U. S. as a McGown Teacher and a Canadian Certified Teacher. Anne lives in Brampton, Ontario and is a well respected teacher in both countries, teaching, designing and dyeing fabric. Her articles and rug hooking designs have appeared in periodicals, newsletters and Rug Hooking Magazine. Anne has played leadership roles in various rug teaching organizations in the U. S. and Canada. Her favorite part of rug hooking is color and dyeing creatively, always trying something different to be on the cutting edge.
