



WHAT WE DO

- Each year the Ontario Hooking Craft Guild (O.H.C.G.) holds its Annual Meeting in a different part of the province and features a large display of members' work. This display is open to the public.
- The Guild promotes local workshops and area branches are encouraged to hold local displays.
- Each year a residential school is organized by the Guild where members are encouraged to develop new skills and ideas in a relaxed and friendly atmosphere.

HOW THE GUILD OPERATES

- There are many regional branches throughout the province and most members are affiliated with a group.
